MOST IMPORTANT STEP:

- Every person who enters as owners, trainers and riders must sign the **Entry Agreements and Waiver of Liability** for each horse. This will be available in the show office when you check in.
- You can stop and start online entry as many times as you need, until you click "I have reviewed" and "SUBMIT".
- You are not finished until you click "I have reviewed" and "SUBMIT" The show secretary will not be able to import your entry until you do this.

OWNER / TRAINER / RIDER Do this for every person associated with this entry

- Gather all the usual information you need when filling out entry forms: membership numbers, correct spellings
 of names for you, your horse, and anyone else who might ride or train your horse or coach you --this year.
 You'll also need everyone's correct address, email, and phone; rider birthdate; horse's birthdate, gender,
 breed.
- Enter NWHA Membership number in the box "Association"." If you are not an NWHA member, leave this blank and you will be able to purchase a day card at the show for adults showing.
- If no trainer, enter "NONE"
- There is a field for Social Security numbers (SSN). Leave this field blank.
- You can enter multiple rider/handlers for all of this owner's horses by clicking "Add Rider".
- Credit Card information. Do NOT fill this in. A blank signed check will be required at check-in at the show, and at check-out, you will be able to pay by credit card and your blank check will be returned.

HORSE AND CLASS ENTRIES do this for every horse associated with this entry

- You can enter multiple horses for same Owner by clicking "Add Horse".
- Horse names must be EXACTLY as they appear on registration papers. If not registered, then must be entered
- under the exact name the horse is known by/shown under.
- Horse birthdates are required to be entered as XX/XX/XX example: 01/01/05
- Horse color, damn and sire: Do NOT fill these in.
- All classes have 3 digits. (001, 035, 100 etc)
- Be sure to select a Rider# for each class.

COGGINS & HEALTH CERTIFICATES

- Bring a copy of your Coggins for each horse to the show office when you check in.
- Per Ohio State Law, a health certificate is required for any horse traveling to the show from out of state.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS AND FEES

• Drop down to "Additional Items and Fees" to add your Mandatory per horse fees and any additional items that you need such as Office Fee, Affiliation fee, Sponsorships, Membership renewal etc.

STALL REQUESTS and CAMPER RESERVATIONS

- Stall requests must be emailed to Matt Janisch at: Janischmatt1@gmail.com and put "stall reservations" in subject line. Be sure to get a response from Matt. NOTE: Each stall comes with 2 bags of shavings. Additional shavings can be purchased separately at the show.
- Camper spots are plentiful and on a first come basis. No reservations needed.
